IAG's share registry, ASX Perpetual Registrars Limited, provides shareholders with access to their holding details over the internet. By visiting www.asxperpetual.com.au shareholders can:

- Check current and previous holding balances;
- Lodge their Tax File Number (TFN), Australian Business Number (ABN) or exemption – if these details are not lodged, IAG is obliged to deduct tax at the highest marginal rate (plus the medicare levy) from the unfranked portion of any dividend payment;
- Check dividend information, instructions and history – dividend payments can be credited directly into any nominated bank, building society or credit union account in Australia;
- Check historical share prices and graphs;
- Request a variety of forms including change of address notification, deceased estate and dividend instruction forms; and
- Sign-up for website membership. Registered members benefit by receiving additional online services such as the ability to create flexible portfolios for easy management of their holdings.

Shareholders can access this information via a security login using their Securityholder Reference Number (SRN) or Holder Identification Number (HIN), as well as their surname or company name and postcode (must be the postcode recorded on holding record).
